Sandra Coulson earned her BA Degree in Speech Therapy and Education in 1965 and her MS in Health Sciences in 2010 from the University of Northern Colorado. She served as Director of a Special Education for the public school system in Tacoma, Washington (1966 -1970), as a speech therapist by Denver Public Schools (1970-1975), as a consultant providing stroke therapy services also in Denver (1970-1973), and as Clinical Instructor at the Community College of Denver (1978-1980). She joined the International Association of Orofacial Myology where she became certified in 1986. She is currently a Life member of the IAOM after serving on their Board of Directors for nine years, on several of their executive boards, and then and as their President, 2005-2007. She has been a Certified Instructor for the IAOM since 2011. She is now a Clinical Professor for the Graduate School of Behavioral Health Sciences where she teaches online courses. She has been in private practice in Orofacial Myology for more than 48 years (1969 - present). Sandra is a consultant for Craig Rehabilitation Center and the National Asthma Research Center in Denver. She has been a public speaker in the field of Orofacial Myology since 1995 and has served as an Advisory Board Member for Heritage College since 1997, often serving as their Commencement Speaker. Sandra is known for her philanthropy in the fields of Dentistry for Children, Senior Resource Center, the Foundation Fighting Blindness, the National Essential Tremor Foundation, and the Courageous Faces Foundation.
