Dr. Hulac has published several articles, is a Clinical Instructor at the Kois Center in Seattle, part of the guest faculty at the Australasian College of Dental Practitioners and an Honorary Assistant Professor at the University of Hong Kong. Her special interests are restorative and cosmetic dentistry, with a focus on minimally invasive and composite dentistry.
